

Hiram College Cambridge Advanced Level Examinations Credit Key

General Policy: Hiram College awards credit for selected Cambridge Advanced Level examinations in which student's earn a grade of "C" or higher. The Registrar's Office determines Hiram College core curriculum and elective credit, while individual departments determine upper level placement as well as credit eligibility to fulfill major requirements.

The chart below lists the Advanced Level examinations for which Hiram awards credit, credit hours awarded, and Hiram College core requirements the credit fulfills.
