

Hiram College International Baccalaureate Examinations Credit Key

General Policy: Hiram College awards credit for Higher Level IB examinations in which students earn a score of 5 or higher. The Registrar's Office determines Hiram College core curriculum or elective credit while individual departments determine upper level placement as well as credit eligibility to fulfill major requirements.

The chart below lists IB examinations for which Hiram College awards credit. Students earning a score of 5 receive 4 hours of credit for each examination; for scores of 6 or 7, students earn 8 hours of credit per examination. The chart also displays the Hiram College core curriculum requirement the credit fulfills.
