Henry Field Usage Policies

Henry Field is designated for the use by Hiram College students, faculty, staff, Sports Center Club members and individuals who have permission from an authorized college official. All individuals are expected to adhere to the following as it pertains to Henry Field

- No dogs or pets of any kind
- •No vehicles permitted except for approved maintenance and emergency
- •No bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, strollers
- No food or drink (water is permitted)
- No alcoholic beverages
- No glass containers
- •No sunflower seeds or gum
- No tobacco products
- •No fireworks or any open flame
- •No golfing, shot putting, javelin, or discus throwing
- No unauthorized use of model planes or rockets
- •No unauthorized painting, tape or other adhesive material shall be placed on the field
- •No stakes, spikes, high heeled shoes or other pointed materials
- •Only free standing field markers and equipment may be used
- Appropriate liter and recycling receptacles are to be used to discard waste material
- •Patrons using outdoor track should be aware of the activity taking place on the field to insure personal safety
