General Use Policies

All patrons using the Complex will be expected to act in accordance with the following:

The Sports Complex is reserved solely for the use of Hiram College students, faculty, staff, alumni and Sports Center Club members. Patrons must be prepared to present their valid Hiram College ID/guest pass to a Sports Center staff member.

Children under the age of 18 must be directly supervised by a parent/guardian at all times. Children should use locker rooms and restrooms appropriate for their gender. Parents with toddlers should use the family restroom located in the lobby.

Conduct rules/regulations per college, village, state and/or federal mandates apply to the Sports Complex. Patrons are expected to behave in a manner that will not detract from the enjoyment of others using the facilities.

Patrons are expected to adhere to the guidelines and procedures approved for activity designed for the various venues throughout the Sports Complex. Proper attire for the venue/activity is required.

Patrons are expected to consult their personal physician before engaging in an exercise program that takes place in any venue in the Sports Complex.

Any accident/injury/incident should be reported to a Sports Center staff member in a timely fashion and should be followed by completion/submission of the appropriate Incident Report Form and/or Accident Report Form.

In the case of an emergency, patrons should use one of the campus phones which are positioned throughout the facility (Lobby/Fleming FH/Martin FH) and follow the posted instructions.

In the event of a tornado/warning patrons are to proceed immediately to the hallways connecting Price Gymnasium to Fleming Fieldhouse.

Patrons are responsible for making sure that personal items are secured appropriately. The Sports Center staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Lockers are available. Only Sports Center issued locks may be used on lockers in the facility.

Lost and found items are stored for thirty days. Any items not claimed by that time will be either discarded or given to charity. Items of significant value (as determined by the Sports Center staff) are turned over to college security. Items can be claimed by rightful owner upon presentation of personal identification and a description of the missing item(s).

No person using the Sports Complex shall possess or use any alcoholic beverage except when it is made available at a college approved event. This policy extends to playing fields, parking lots and surrounding areas. The use or sharing of alcoholic beverages with individuals under the age of 21 is a violation of Hiram College regulations.

All public areas in the Sports Center are 'tobacco free'. Patrons may not smoke/chew tobacco products of any kind in the facility.

Demonstrators of dissent, which lead to interference with the freedom of others to use the facilities, will not be tolerated. The destruction of college property and/or obstruction of college sponsored activities is prohibited.

Patrons may post information on 'designated' general bulletin boards. These postings must be in compliance with college policies. Any additional postings must be pre-approved by the Sports Center staff.

Bicycles, skateboards, scooters, roller blades, snow mobiles and/or three wheelers are not to be brought inside the Sports Center or used on Hiram College outdoor fields/facilities.

Pets are not permitted in the common areas in the Sports Center. Approved guide dogs for the visually impaired are welcome.

Selected activities require the use of Sports Center equipment, or pre-approved equipment, in order to protect the facility (i.e. functions in a field house which require protective cover for the floor).

Open-air radios/stereos, other than personal listening devices, unless approved by the Sports Center staff in a specific area, are prohibited. Building sound systems are to be operated by the Sports Center staff.

Martin FH/Fleming FH/Price Gym

Price Gymnasium is home to intercollegiate volleyball and basketball, intramurals and approved court activities. The two field houses are multipurpose venues with a rubberized surface, with the flexibility to host, basketball, volleyball, baseball, softball, soccer, and a variety of other activities.

Patrons who are engaged in physical activity are required to wear clean (non-marking) shoes that are appropriate for the surface. Spikes or cleats are not permitted.

Patrons are expected to use the facility and the equipment in an appropriate manner. Only Sports Center staff members/designees are permitted to authorize the use of equipment located in the facility (batting cages, volleyball equipment, baseball/softball equipment, etc.).

Activities that have the potential to damage the floor, walls, windows, lights or ceiling, are not permitted.

Food/drinks are not permitted unless specifically approved by the Sports Center staff. Water must be in a closed/unbreakable container.

Andrews Fitness Ctr/Conner Weight Room

Located on the lower level of the Sports Center, these two rooms offer a variety of choices for individual training regimens. The cardio-theater venue houses treadmills, ellipticals, stair climbers, bikes, selectorized Quantum machines and stability balls for core body strengthening. Across the hall is a full array of Olympic free weights.

Patrons are expected to sign-in/out at the monitor's desk. Patrons are expected to use the sanitizing hand wipes to clean all contact surfaces before/after use.

Patrons are expected to wear appropriate clothing to include; a shirt, pants, and clean (closed-toe) indoor shoes.

Equipment/weights are to be used in the manner intended and returned to the proper place.

Patrons are encouraged to ask for assistance. Please do not attempt to use equipment with which you are unfamiliar.

Report all injuries and faulty/broken equipment to the monitor on duty.

The music is controlled by the Sports Center staff. Open-air radios/stereos are prohibited.

When scheduled in advance, coaches may exercise priority use for their team. Exercise stations not being used by that team are available for general use.

Food/drinks are not permitted unless specifically approved by the Sports Center staff. Water must be in a closed/unbreakable container.

Steinem Aerobics Studio

Located across from the Administrative Suite, the Studio is home to aerobics, yoga, pilates, dance and other cardio activity for individual and group sessions.

Patrons are expected to use the facility and the equipment in an appropriate manner. Only Sports Center staff members/designees are permitted to authorize the use of equipment stored in the closet (i.e. mats, exercise equipment, etc.). No sport balls are permitted.

Proper exercise attire and footwear are required. Appropriate non-marking court shoes or dance shoes are permitted. No street shoes, boots, sandals, bare feet and/or marking footwear are allowed when taking part in a physical activity or program.

Equipment/furniture that is placed on the floor must be appropriately cushioned to protect the wood finish. Tape (or other markings) must be approved by the Sports Center staff.

Activities that have the potential to cause damage to the floor, mirrors, walls, windows, lights or ceiling are not permitted.

Food/gum/drinks are not permitted unless specifically approved by the Sports Center staff. Water must be in a closed/unbreakable container.

Scheduled programming has priority usage of this area. The studio is available for individual workouts during free periods. You may provide your own workout tape.

Please turn the television and VCR off when leaving the room. The volume may be adjusted, but it must remain at a level that does not disrupt other activity in the Sports Center.

Indoor Track

Located above Martin field house, the tenth-of-a-mile, three-lane track provides special views of the Hiram landscape.

Patrons are required to wear a clean pair of shoes (with non-marking soles) on the track. Please, no spikes, no cleats, no socks and no bare feet.

Food/drinks are not permitted unless specifically approved by the Sports Center staff. Water must be in a closed/unbreakable container.

Patrons are expected to adhere to the direction of Walking/jogging that is posted for each day.

Alumni Memorial Pool

Located on the second floor overlooking Price Gym, the pool is a six-lane, 25-meter facility which is home to intercollegiate swimming, scuba diving, water polo, intramurals, swim classes and open lap swim.

The lifeguard on duty is responsible for the safety/security of all patrons who are in the pool and on the deck. Patrons are not permitted to be in the water unless there is an approved/certified lifeguard on duty.

Patrons are expected to shower before entering the pool. Swimsuits are required for all swimmers.

Diving from the deck is permitted in water over 8 feet deep.

Dives from either board are at the discretion of the lifeguard. Only one person is permitted on a board at a time. Please do not hang on the board or on lane lines.

Only Sports Center staff members/designees are permitted to authorize the use of equipment located in the facility (i.e. starting blocks, exercise equipment). Flotation devices are to be used at the discretion of the lifeguard on duty.

Food/drinks are not permitted on the deck/in the pool unless specifically approved by the Sports Center staff. Water must be in a closed/unbreakable container.

Krabill & Morris Racquetball Courts

Located on the lower level across from the Fitness Center, the two courts are designed for racquetball and wallyball.

Patrons are expected to use the courts in an appropriate manner. Using the courts for any other type of activity must have the permission of the Sports Center staff or designees. No sport balls are permitted.

Proper exercise attire and footwear are required. Only clean/non-marking court shoes are permitted.

Players are expected to wear appropriate protective eyewear and a lanyard on the racquet during play.

Metal racquets must be equipped with a protective head guard to avoid damaging the walls.

Priority is given to classes, intramurals/approved organized activities and recreational play by students, faculty and staff and/or Sports Center Club members.

Court reservations are based upon a first come/first serve sign up basis. The sign-up sheet is located outside the racquetball courts.

Both courts are limited to one hour of playing time per group starting on the hour (per the clock located on the north wall of the Fitness Center). If a court has not been reserved for a specific hourly time block, play is permitted on a first come/first serve basis until the next reservation time. It is not appropriate for one person or group to reserve the court for consecutive time blocks.

Martial Arts Room

Located above Fleming Fieldhouse, this 'former' squash court is home to a variety of activities to include; martial arts, self-defense, and other appropriate individual/group activities.

Walt Peckinpugh Tennis Complex

The three courts, located across from East Hall, serve tennis classes, intramurals and open play.

Charles A. Henry Field

Henry Field is the primary home to intercollegiate football and lacrosse. The facility is designated for use by Hiram College students, faculty, staff, Sports Club members and individuals all of whom have permission from an authorized college official. All individuals are expected to adhere to the following as it pertains to Henry Field.

No dogs or pets of any kind
No vehicles except for approved maintenance/emergency
No bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards, strollers
No food or drink (water is permitted)
No alcoholic beverages
No glass containers
No sunflower seeds or gum
No tobacco products
No fireworks or any open flame
No golfing, shot putting, discus throwing, javelin
No model planes or rockets
No painting, tape or any adhesive material on the field
No stakes, spikes, high heeled shoes or other pointed material
